SERMON SUMMARY

Revelation 6:9-17

Pastor Art returned to his sermon series on the Book of Revelation with a sermon on "Opening of the 5th and 6th Seal," based on Revelation 6:9-17. He asked everyone why we study the book of Revelation. Clearly, we believe that we will be raptured to heaven as believers and not experiencing the Tribulation. So why study it? The reason is really simple, so that we can explain what happens to those left behind that have not professed Jesus as their Savior and Lord of their lives. Persecution of Christians started at the time of the cross. It will not stop. When the church is raptured, persecution dramatically increases. This will result in tribulation saints. There will also be people who are unaware of the rapture. Sort of anticipate that those who have been sitting on the fence will suddenly be caught up in revival and become persecuted by the non-believers. Pastor Art received an epiphany from God regarding 6 questions this scripture passage addresses.

Who are the souls under the altar? These are the individuals who gave their hearts to Christ after they saw the rapture of the church. They knew who Christ was but hadn't accepted Him as Savior and Lord. They are slain for their testimony. Read Revelation 1:9.

Why are they there? Read Leviticus 4, which explains that the blood has to be placed under the altar. These are the tribulation saints. They have been slain for their faith. The Anti-Christ and followers will kill believers. Read Matthew 10:28.
