MORNING TIME ON THE PORCH

SERMON SUMMARY

Revelation 6:12-17

Wednesday, 7/10 -Ecclesiastes 4:9-12 "Friends in Christ." Read James 4:7 and Proverbs 18:24.

Thursday, 7/11 - Philippians 4:8-9 "Staying Positive as a Christ Follower." Read Philippians 4:4.

Friday, 7/12 - Titus 2:11-15 "Anticipation." Read Psalm 46:10.

Pastor Art continued his sermon series on the Book of Revelation with a sermon entitled "A Scene in Heaven." and Cosmic Disturbances," based on Revelation 6:12-17. The Bible is written for a specific purpose. It is God's Word. It is truth. Jesus is the only way! Last week we were given a heavenly picture that revealed information about the tribulation saints, who were martyrs. The apostle John is giving you a description of what he is seeing. The time frame for Revelation is not linear but rather circular. In this scripture passage, the sixth seal is broken and reveals amazing things. First and foremost, God is calling on you to speak the gospel to those around you. This passage begins with great earthquakes and solar and lunar changes. Jesus is the one who opens the seal to release these changes. Read Isaiah 17:1, Zechariah 14:6-7, and Joel 2:31 as a reminder that God causes unusual things to happen, then, now and in the future. Sacrifice was an appointment not an accident. Even in the death of His people, God is in control. Read I John 5:19 and Psalm 116:15. After the rapture, there is a remnant of people that will come to Christ immediately following the rapture. From the moment you accept Christ, you become a saint. You are covered in righteousness by Christ's blood. Revelation 6:13, it is a picture of intense meteor showers or a picture from Desert Storm. Gulf War's nights were filled with missiles. Read Isaiah 34:4. God can and does do amazing things. Read Joshua 10:12-13 and Isaiah 24:1-13. There will be worldwide panic by those who refused Christ, who worshipped self or other things.

FINAL REPORT ON VETERANS SERVICE PROJECT FOR VALOR RANCH

Special thanks to everyone who reached out to support this year's veterans service project. As you know Valor Ranch asked primarily for underwear, t-shirts and socks for the homeless veterans they serve. You went way beyond the requested items. Here's a numeric summary of what we did this year. We collected 31 packages of new clothing items ranging from 3 to 30 items in a package. We collected an additional 25 assorted clothing items as well as 2 pairs of men's shoes. We collected 14 personal hygiene items in addition to 2 packages of combs. A total of \$2400 was collected to support their outreach. Your support of veterans in the Clay and Ray area was very much appreciated.
