MORNING TIME ON THE PORCH

Monday 7/22 - Ephesians 1:13-14 "Sealed by the Holy Spirit." Read Ephesians 4:20, Revelation 7:3, Romans 8:38-39 and II Corinthians 1:21-22.

Tuesday, 7/23 - Jeremiah 29:1, 4-7 "Pray and Experience Peace." Read II Chronicles 7:14.

Wednesday, 7/24 - Luke 15:20-24 "Expectancy involved in Homecoming." Read Revelation 7:9.

Thursday, 7/25 - Psalm 5:1-3 "Early Morning Prayer." Read I Thessalonians 5:17-18 and James 5:15-16.

Friday, 7/26 - Revelation 7:9-17 "Throne Room Celebration." Read John 12:13 and John 19:15.

SERMON SUMMARY

Revelation 7:9-17 – God in His Wrath, Remember Mercy

Pastor Art picked up where he left off last week in his sermon "God in His Wrath, Remember Mercy - Part 2," based on Revelation 7:9-17. Pastor Art stated that he was so thankful for chapter 7 of the book of Revelation because it gives us a picture of God's mercy even in the hardest of times. He stressed again the importance of reading and understanding the Bible. Read Romans 8:28. He also pointed out that verse 17 is the most popular verse in the world because it talks about God wiping away our tears. Read John 14:6. Then he gave the most important point of this chapter in Revelation, which is don't wait. Don't put off salvation.

The earlier part of chapter 7 talks about the remnant of Israel, the 144,000 called to evangelize. They listened and acted on the Great Commission. Read Matthew 28:19-20 and Mark 16:15. The significance of the white robes in today's scripture passage reveal that all sins have been washed away. They are clothed in righteousness because of Jesus Christ. Read Romans 10:9. The palm branches that are being waved are a picture of victory.

Verse 12 reveals the seven parts of worship. Worship is giving praise and worth to something; edification. Amen signifies that everyone agrees. Worship includes 1) Blessing, 2) Glory, 3) Wisdom, 4) Thanksgiving, 5) Honor, 6) Power, and 7) Might (incomparable strength). Pastor Art reminded us that there are 3 groups in heaven at this particular moment: 1) Jews (specifically


Read Psalm 5:1-3

the 144,000 called out during the tribulation), 2) Gentiles (those who have been evangelized), and 3) the Raptured Church.

Verse 16 shows the Lamb shepherding them to the living water. Read John 10:11 and Jeremiah 2:4. This passage is a picture of Psalm 23, because the shepherd provides everything that we need.
