A Gospel Proclaiming Angel - Rev. 14:6-7

Pastor Art returned to the book of Revelation with a sermon entitled "A Gospel Proclaiming Angel," based on Revelation 14:6-7. The Bible is literal. If God says it, then God means it. Pastor Art shared a quote from former president Ronald Reagan, "Within the covers of the Bible are the answers for all the problems men face." He then reviewed key characters in chapter 13 in the book of Revelation and in the first part of chapter 14. To understand the significance of the 144,000 sealed believers read Revelation 7:1-8.

This portion of Revelation is in the parenthetical statement. A parenthetical statement gives an overview like a panoramic camera picture. In this scripture passage, we see a picture of an angel. John writes what he sees and hears through the tribulation. This passage reminds us that God ensures the gospel is being shared.

Celebration of Living with Jesus. We are the bride of Christ and are pure because Jesus forgave our sins. What matters is who is raptured. Bear in mind that only believers will be raptured.

This was eye witness testimony by John, in verse 6, he describes an angel that is different from the others. This angel is flying around the earth in the atmosphere. It is the first time that an angel proclaims the gospel. The angel appears after the rapture of the church. This fulfills God's promise to proclaim the
